

# MetaX - Error Messages

---

MetaX has several error messages that it uses to alert you when something has gone wrong. If you wish to have MetaX run unattended, there is an option in Preferences to Reply Yes to All Confirmations. Some of the messages that fall into this category are:

1. If there is already a file in the deleted directory with the same name as the one you are writing, or with the name that you are renaming the output file to, MetaX will ask if it should overwrite it.
2. If there is an archive entry with the title of the file you are writing, MetaX will ask if it should overwrite it.
3. If you are updating iTunes and the title exists in iTunes, but not as the current type (Movie, TV Show, ...) it will ask if it should delete the existing entry. iTunes will not allow a Movie and TV Show (for example) with the same name.
4. If the number of chapters in a search entry is different from what is in the file, MetaX will ask if you want to use what is in the search entry.
5. If there are chapter durations in a search entry, MetaX will ask if you want to use them.

Other error conditions or status events will be displayed in the status field in the lower right section of the main form. Also, all the errors and status messages are saved in a file called `metax.log`. This file is overwritten every time you start up MetaX.
